Adjournment petition is filed on behalf of accused. The same is considered and allowed. The O.C.R has not been received as of yet.

The accused person has filed a petition stating that the accused was enlarged on bail on 03.11.2021 upon a condition to submit original voter ID card. The accused had prayed to submit the original passport instead, as he was unable to produce the voter id card due to unavoidable circumstance. The prayer was accepted and accordingly he had submitted the original passport. It is next stated that the accused is ready to submit the voter id card and as such he prays that the original passport is returned to him.

Heard the submission of Ld. Counsel for the accused and Ld. APP. No objection has been raised.

Perused and considered. The accused person has submitted his original Voter ID card.

The date of birth recorded in the pass port is 01.01.1980 and the date of birth recorded in the voter I.D Card is 03.08.1982. All other particulars such as father's name and address appear to be the same.

This court opines that submission of the voter id card is towards compliance of the condition for bail. As such, this court finds it proper to accept the voter id card submitted and return the passport to the accused.

Let the original voter ID card be accepted as condition for bail and kept accordingly.

Let the original passport be returned to the accused.
