The operative portion of the judgment is as follows:-

Hence, it is

ORDERED

That the accused persons namely **1).**Sirajul Molla, **2).**Faijul Sarkar @ Fayjula Molla, both son of Rahed Ali @ Ahet Ali Mia @ Ahed Ali, **3).** Mahasena Bibi @ Mamina Bibi, w/o. Faijul Sarkar, **4).**Rojina Bibi @ Rujina Khatun Bibi, w/o. Sirajul Molla and **5).**Najbin Bibi @ Najmin Khatun w/o. Ajijur Sarkar, all resident of Vill. Uttar Sarifabad, P.S.Tapan, District – Dakshin Dinajpur are found not guilty of the offence u/s.341/323/307/506/354/34 of IPC

The accused persons are hereby acquitted under section 235(1) Cr.P.C.

The accused persons are discharged from their respective bail bonds.

The accused persons are set at liberty on condition of furnish a bail bond of Rs.1000/- each with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of Ld.C.J.M., Dakshin Dinajpur at Balurghat with further condition that in the event of receiving any notice in connection with an Appeal against this judgment of acquittal, they shall make them make themselves available before the Appellate Court without fail.

Fresh bail bond if furnished shall remain inforce for a period of 06 (six) months.

Seized alamats (Bamboo sticks) be destroyed after expiry of statutory period of Appeal.

The victims have the right to prefer an appeal under the proviso to Sec. 372 CrPC and if entitled they can avail free legal assistance through the legal services authorities concerned to prefer an appeal against the judgement of acquittal of the accused persons.

Let a copy of this judgement be sent to the Ld. Secretary, D.L.S.A., Dakshin Dinajpur and the District Magistrate, Dakshin Dinajpur for intimating the same to the victim as per direction of the Hon'ble High Court.

Let copy of this order be sent to the Ld. C.J.M., Dakshin Dinajpur at Balurghat.
