ORDER:-

1. Applicant/accused has filed the present application under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) for grant of regular bail.
2. Report of Ahlmad received that no bail application qua the same applicant is pending or decided by any court.

3. Notice of bail application was given to I.O./SHO and ASI Gurdeep Singh, No. 1367/SAS Nagar now posted at Police Station Sadar Kharar appeared and suffered a separate statement that this is the first regular bail application filed by the applicant/accused. No other offence has been added in the present case. No other FIR is found to be registered against applicant/accused. Recovery is of one .12 bore country made pistol and two live cartridges from the applicant/accused. He is in custody since 04.05.2026.

4. The brief facts are that the present FIR was registered on the 29.04.2026 when ASI Gurdeep Singh was present in the area of Village Nayashahr Badala where at around 07:00 PM, he received secret information that accused Vikas alias Lucky who was having many cases registered against, was having illegal weapon and was going towards Kharar side in Verna car bearing registration no. PB-10-DX-1001 and if a raid was conducted at *Bara* of accused in Village Badali, he could be apprehended alongwith illegal weapon(s).

5. Counsel for the applicant/accused has argued that applicant/accused is a young boy of 19 years of age. Applicant/.accused is in custody since 04.05.2026. He has been nominated on the basis of disclosure statement of one Lakhi with whom he has no concern. So he prayed that bail application be allowed.

6. On the other hand, ld. Addl. PP has argued that offence is serious in nature as illegal arm and ammunition has been recovered from the possession of applicant/accused. He is a criminal type of person. So he prayed that bail application be dismissed.

7. Rival contentions heard and record perused.
8. Allegations against the applicant/accused are that one .12 bore countrymade pistol has been recovered from his possession. There is no other FIR registered against the applicant/accused. He is in custody since 04.05.2026. Applicant is young boy of 19 years having no criminal antecedents. Challan is yet to be presented. Completion of investigation and conclusion of trial will take its own time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the applicant/accused behind bars for indefinite period.

Hence, without commenting anything upon the merits of the case, bail application stands allowed and applicant-accused **Pardeep Singh @ Billi** is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds in sum of **₹50,000/-** with one surety of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the concerned **Illaqa/Duty Magistrate**, subject to the conditions:

1. That the applicant shall attend the court on every date of hearing.
2. That the applicant shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused.
3. That the applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer and shall not tamper with the evidence in the matter.
4. That the applicant shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court.
