ORDER

Record received and perused. I have heard the learned counsel
for the accused and learned Addl. PP for the State.

2. After hearing rival contentions of the parties and perusing the
file, I am of the considered opinion that the applicant/accused is entitled to

the benefit of bail. The accused has been confined in the present case since 21.06.2025. As per prosecution version criminal law was set into motion against the accused persons on the statement of complainant Jaspal Singh that on 10th May 2025 at around 1:30 PM, while he was at home with the outer gate shut, a group including Sahil Cheema, Dalbir Kumar @ Gopi, Jashan, Gori Cheema, Rohit, and some unknown persons came to his house and tried to break the main gate using a sickle. Out of fear, he did not open the gate and climbed to the rooftop, raising an alarm. At that moment, Gopi allegedly fired a shot into the air, after which the group fled off the spot. Jaspal Singh also mentioned that his son Arshdeep Singh continues to receive threats on Instagram. Police action began the same day upon receiving a call and later on 15th May 2025, a formal complaint was lodged. An FIR was registered under serious sections of BNS and the Arms Act. As per prosecution version no injury was inflicted on the person of complainant or any other member of complainant party. The other offences in which the applicant/accused is implicated are bailable one. The veracity and genuineness of the allegations levelled against the accused/applicant are yet to be determined at the alter of evidence, but in this case, challan is yet to be presented. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant/accused behind the bars. Moreover accused would be a burden on the State Exchequer and no work can be taken from him under the rules in the jail. Accordingly, this bail application stands allowed and applicant/ accused **Jashanpreet Singh @ Jashan** be admitted to bail on his furnishing personal bail bond in the sum of **Rs.50,000/-** with

one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he will not tamper with the prosecution evidence;
2. That he will appear in the court on each and every date of hearing to be fixed in the trial;
3. That he will not leave the territory of India without prior permission of the Court;

Learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate is also directed to accept the cash surety if presented by the accused. Copy of this order be sent to the learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate for compliance. Copy of this order be also sent to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Kapurthala through email for intimation and necessary action, if any. This bail application file be consigned to the record room, after due compliance.
