ORDER:

1. Record received. Heard. It is mentioned in the instant bail application that applicant has not committed an offence and has been falsely implicated in the present case by the police of P.S.Lehra. It is further averred that applicant is in judicial custody since long, hence no more required by the police for further investigation. It is further averred that presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take long time and

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no useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused/applicant in custody. Hence, it is prayed that applicant/accused may kindly be released on bail.

2. Learned counsel for the accused/applicant while arguing in the lines of bail application contended that bail application may be allowed.

3. Conversely, learned Addl.P.P. for the State contended that there are serious allegations against the accused/applicant and therefore, bail application may be dismissed.

4. After hearing rival submissions, it has transpired that instant case FIR was registered when on 27.06.2023 Jasvir Singh and Balvir Singh (applicant) on motorcycle were apprehended and from them 1500 tablets Tramadol and 1850 tablets Alprazolam were recovered. On further investigation of the matter, accused Jarnail Singh and Boota Singh were also apprehended and from them, 950 intoxicant tablets were recovered on 02.07.2023 and during their interrogation, name of accused Raj Kumar and Vishant Chauhan cropped up. On 06.07.2023 accused Vishant Chauhan and Raj Kumar were apprehended and from them total 24500 intoxicant tablets were recovered.

5. The contraband allegedly recovered in the present case is of enormous commercial quantity and keeping in view the same, accused/applicant does not stand entitled to the concession of bail.

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Resultantly, bail application is ordered to be dismissed. Police record be returned. Bail application file be attached with main file.
