Today the case was fixed for consideration.

2. The report of SHO received wherein it is stated that total amount of Rs. 2,42,400/- has been put on hold in various bank accounts as mentioned in the report and police has no objection on transferring the said amount in the bank account of complainant/applicant.

3. Heard. In view of no objection by the police as well as the statement suffered by the learned counsel for the applicant, the hold amount of Rs. 2,42,400/- shall be released/transferred in the bank account of complainant/applicant to the satisfaction of SHO concerned subject to furnishing of supurdginama and indemnity bonds and only after obtaining the requisite no objection from the concerned Bank in terms of instructions issued by Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court vide letter bearing endorsement no. 1536 Spl.Gaz.II.17 dated 07.06.2024 regarding non-insistence on FIR registration for release of de-frauded amount in Cyber Crime Cases. The complainant shall return the above said amount, in case any other person proves his claim to the said amount. The SHO concerned as well as the bank concerned are directed to comply with above said order subject to any objection from the concerned bank. A copy of this order be sent to SHO concerned, immediately, for compliance. Hence, present **application disposed off**. Papers be tagged with FIR/main case, if any, otherwise shall be consigned to record room after due compliance.
