ORDER

Perused the application and the reply filed by Kurar Police Station. Heard Ld. Advocate Mr.R.R.Mishra for the Applicants/Accused and Ld. Addl.P.P. Mr.Savle for the State.

2. Accused wants to get protected from the fear of arrest by the Investigating Officer while Investigating Officer requires presence of the applicant/accused for enquiry purpose. Yet the offence is yet to be registered. In aforesaid circumstances, following order is passed:

ORDER

1. Applicants/Accused Nos.1, 2, 4 and 5 respectively Puneet Surendranath Tiwari, Surendranath Kapildev Tiwari, Amit Surendranath Tiwari and Mrs.Pinki Chandrabhushan Mishra shall attend the Kurar Police Station initially on 27/3/2021 between 11.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon and thereafter whenever Investigating Officer shall call for and shall co-operative in the investigation/enquiry.
2. The exemption is granted to the applicant/accused No.3 Mrs.Mina Surendranath Tiwari from attending the police station. However, with liberty to the Investigating Officer, if require, to attend her house and make necessary enquiry with her.

3. Though it is so, if the Investigating Officer prefers to register the crime and feels that applicants/accused are necessary to be arrested, he shall give advance notice in writing of 72 hours to the applicants/accused and then shall follow the appropriate procedure.

4. Anticipatory Bail Application No.417/2021 stands disposed of.
