ORDER.

Gurinder Singh (applicant/accused) has filed instant bail application *under Section 482 BNSS (Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita)* for grant of pre-arrest bail in the above noted case, on the grounds of false implication.

2. Vide Order dated **29.05.2026**, applicant/accused was granted interim anticipatory bail to join the investigation within four days.

3. I have heard rival submissions put forth by learned counsel for the parties, and have gone through record with their able assistance.

4. **Learned Addl.PP for the State** has vehemently opposed the bail application and submitted that, since applicant/accused committed serious offence, therefore, opposed prayer.

5. ***Assistant Sub Inspector Gurbhinder Singh No.299/FZR, Police Station Talwandi Bhai, Ferozepur***, has appeared and suffered statement that applicant/accused has joined the investigation of this case on 15.06.2026, in pursuance of order dated 29.05.2026.

6. From above discussion, it transpires that **Gurinder Singh** (applicant/accused) has already joined the investigation, in pursuance of order dated **29.05.2026**, so the interim bail order ***dated 29.05.2026*** stands ***confirmed and made absolute***, subject to the following conditions :-

1. That the applicant-accused will not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner.
2. That the applicant-accused will not leave the limits of India without prior permission of the court.

3. That the applicant-accused will attend the court on each and every date.

However, these observation of mine shall have no effect on the merits of the case. File be consigned to record room.
