

Kulwinder Singh etc. Versus State of Punjab

Heard on the application for anticipatory bail of the applicants/petitioners Kulwinder Singh and Manjit Singh, in the case FIR No. 125 of 06.08.2015, Police Station Maur, District Bathinda

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners i.e. Kulwinder Singh and Manjit Singh that they were named by the complainant in his initial statement but during investigation by the police they were found innocent and as such, challan was presented against them by placing them in column No.2 of the same. Now, the petitioners have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.PC, who are ready to surrender before the trial court and to face the proceedings.

Record shows that the petitioners have been summoned u/s 319 Cr.P.C. to face trial under sections 447, 326, 323, 506 IPC, in this case alongwith other accused. The applicants/petitioners are ready to appear before the trial court and to face the proceedings. Therefore, custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required as they are to appear in the Court itself. The petitioners further undertake to abide by the terms and conditions of bail.

In view of the above, nature of allegations levelled against the petitioners and other facts of the case, the applicants/ petitioners are directed to surrender before the trial court on or before the date fixed there. In case of their arrest in this case, they be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr P C or any other conditions, to be imposed by the trial court.

The application stands allowed. Copy of this order be placed on the Trial Court record which be sent back, immediately.
