Trial court record received and perusal of the same reveals that accused-applicant Harpreet has furnished the bail/surety bonds in terms of order dated 31.8.2018 passed by the undersigned. The applicant is seeking anticipatory bail in the main trial which he is facing before the court at Dasuya. The applicant has pleaded that on 26.7.2018, he could not appear in the court due to fracture of hip and his non-bailable warrants were issued by the trial court. In the facts and circumstances of the case, he is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail. Hence, bail application filed by the applicant Rajvir Singh under Section 438 Cr.P.C is allowed and interim bail granted to him vide order dated 31.8.2018 passed by the undersigned is made absolute subject to conditions that he shall appear in the court on each and every date of hearing, he will not leave India without prior permission of the court and that he shall not tamper with evidence of complainant.
