ORDER BELOW BAIL APPLICATION NO. 449/BA/2026

1. This is the bail application by the accused Vinay Vikram Singh Rawat. Read application, say of Ld. APP and IO. Heard both sides. Perused the documents.
2. It appears from the remand report that offence is under Section 318(2), 336(3), 336(4), 337, 340(2) & 204 of BNS is registered against the accused. Ld. Advocate for accused submitted that accused is falsely implicated in this case. He is not having any nexus with the said offence. There is no reason to keep the accused behind the bar. Hence, he prayed to release the accused on bail.
3. Application strongly resisted by the IO and Ld. APP.
4. On perusal of remand papers, it appears that accused was arrested on 26.07.2026. Initially he was remanded to police custody and thereafter, sent in Judicial custody. It appears that during the investigation, Investigating Officer has arrested in all total seven accused. There are allegations that accused persons prepared forged letter head of Governor of Maharashtra and used that letter head for reservation of railway tickets. The offence is serious in nature. Investigation is in progress. The possibility of absconding the accused also cannot be ruled out. Investigation is at primary stage. If accused is released on bail, there is every possibility of tampering of evidence and pressurizing the witnesses. This is not a proper stage to release the accused on bail. Hence the order :-
