Paramjit Kaur and anr vs. State

ASI Gurjit Singh appeared along-with record and made a statement that applicant/accused Paramjit Kaur and Narinder Singh had joined the investigation on 24.06.2020 and all dowry articles except five gold rings, one gold chain, one gold Karra, one silver Pajeb, one gold set ear-rings, clothes and ₹2,00,000/- as per the FIR are recovered from applicants/accused Paramjit Kaur and Narinder Singh.

Learned counsel for the applicants/accused has submitted that all the dowry articles in the possession of applicants/accused have already been handed over to the investigating officer and now nothing is in the possession of applicants/accused, whereas learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that recovery of remaining dowry articles as stated by ASI Gurjit Singh Investigating officer are yet to be recovered from the possession of applicant/accused and they may kindly be directed to co-operate with the investigating agency to effect the recovery of said dowry articles. Since some of the dowry articles are yet to be recovered from the possession of applicant/accused as per the allegations of the complainant, therefore, applicant/accused through their counsel are

directed to co-operate with the investigating agency to get effected the recovery of remaining dowry articles if any in their possession. Now to come up on 13.07.2020 for further report of Investigating officer regarding recovery of any other dowry articles from the possession of applicant/accused as well as arguments. Till then interim order to continue.
