1. This order of mine shall dispose of bail application filed on behalf of accused who is in custody in FIR No. 69 dated 02.07.2026 under Section 61/1/85 of Excise Act at Police Station Sherpur.

2. It is mentioned in the application that police of PS Sheprur has falsely implicated the accused/applicant in above noted case, who has committed no offence at all. Nothing has been recovered from the accused/applicant nor any thing is to be recovered from the accused/applicant. This bail application is the 1st regular bail application. No other bail application is pending in any Court of law nor even in the Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh. It will take much time to submit and dispose off the case. The accused/applicant is innocent person and has not committed any offence. The accused/applicant is ready to furnish the bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Hon'ble Court. The accused/applicant will appear before the Hon'ble Court on each and every date of hearing and will not leave India without prior permission of the Hon'ble Court and will abide by the terms and conditions as imposed by the Hon'ble Court. It is, therefore, requested that the application may kindly be allowed and the applicant may kindly be granted bail till the decision of the case.

The learned APP for the State has opposed the bail application of the accused submitting that if bail is granted to the accused, he can jump

the same and also, evade his arrest. The learned APP for the State prays that the bail application in hand be dismissed.

4. Arguments heard. After going through the FIR and bail application along with the case file, meticulously and after hearing learned defence counsel as well as Ld. APP for the State, this Court finds no merits in the bail application of the accused. Therefore, no ground is made out to release the accused-applicant on bail because of the gravity of offences. At this stage, releasing the accused from the custody will send wrong signal to the society as offences are heinous and anti social. Hence, this Court does not deem it fit to enlarge the accused-applicant on bail. Accordingly, bail application filed on behalf of accused-applicant stands **dismissed**.
