Accused person namely Judhisthir Das is produced from J.C and remanded to J.C till next date.

A bail petition is filed on behalf of the said accused **Judhisthir Das**. Copy served.

The said petition is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Adv for the accused person prays for bail on the ground of non-absconsion as the accused being local resident. The prayer is opposed by the Ld. P.P as the investigation is lying at its initial stage.

Heard both sides and considering the materials on record including the quantity of seized contrabands, the prayer for bail of accused Judhisthir Das is hereby **rejected**.

Let the case be registered against the accused person as NDPS Case.

A bail petition along with Vokatnama is filed for accused person upon serving copy.

Ld. Advocate prays for bail of the accused on the grounds of non-absconsion which is opposed by the Ld. P.P. as the case at investigation stage.

Upon consideration of the submission of both sides and considering the mandatory bar under the provision of NDPS Act, the prayer for bail of accused Bikram Laha is hereby rejected.

CD is produced. I.O is present. Heard I.O.

Perused the CD and the forwarding report produced today by the police wherein the police has prayed for Police Custody for the accused Bikram Laha for 07 days by PSI Ananta Mondal of Balurghat P.S duly forwarded & recommended by superior authorities on the grounds stated therein and seen by Ld.P.P.

Considering the materials available in the CD, the prayer of police custody of the accused person namely Bikram Laha is hereby allowed for Four (04) days.

I.O. is directed to ensure that utmost care and caution be taken so that the accused person is not malhandled in any manner whatsoever and to provide him with all possible medical assistance if needed, during the period of police remand. The accused person must be taken for medical check up on each day during police remand.

I.O. is further directed to observe strictly the guidelines set out by the Hon'ble Apex Court of India in this behalf regarding police custody in D. K. Basu Vs State of West Bengal (1997) 1 SCC 416.

Accused person namely Bikram Laha is hereby remanded to **Police Custody till 19-05-2023.**

To **19-05-2023** for production of the accused person namely Bikram Laha from Police Custody with P.C Report along with CD and report in final form.
