This order of mine would dispose off an application U/S 438
Cr.P.C. moved by Sira Singh son of Babra Singh, resident of village
Chahhar (hereinafter to be referred to as bail applicant) in case bearing
FIR No. 06 dated 15.01.2018, U/S 457/380 IPC registered at P.S.Chhajli

2. Notice of this application has been issued to the State, but
no reply has been filed.

3. I have heard the learned counsel for bail applicant and
learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State and carefully perused the
record.

It is the case of complainant Krishan Chand son of Sitam that in the intervening night of 12.01.2018, a gatta containing 40 Kg of Gurr, a gatta containing 50 Kg of Bajra, three gattas weighing 50 Kg each of wheat and a gatta containing 50 Kg of sugar were stolen from his shop by breaking open a part of roof top of the shop, wherein the aforementioned items had been stored by him. It is further his case that accused Gurpiar Singh son of Narata Ram and Jagsir Singh @ Sira had stolen the said items from his shop.

5. Since stolen goods are yet to be recovered, custodial interrogation of bail applicant is indeed called for. In the said circumstances, the present bail application stands dismissed. File be consigned to the record room.
