The sole accused namely Krishna Pahan is produced from Balurghat Central Correctional home through V.C.

Today is fixed for evidence, hearing the petition u/s.294 Cr.P.C and production of accused person.

Ld. Advocate (LADCs) for the accused is present.

Ld. P.P. in-charge files hazira of two witnesses namely Subodh Dey Sarkar (C.S.W.13) and S.I Goutam Hazra (C.S.W.16), who are examined-in-chief as P.W.14 and P.W.15 respectively. They are cross examined in-full and discharged.

During the evidence of P.W.15 the seizure list dt.07.01.2023 is marked as Ext.P-4 and the signature of the witness on the seizure list is marked as Ext.P-4/4, the ‘Zimma nama’ dt.07.01.2023 is marked as Exhibit P-17, the seizure list dt.09.01.2023 is marked as Exhibit P-5, the signature of the witness on the seizure list is marked as Ext.P-5/2, the label dt.09.01.2023 is marked as Ext.P-6 and the signature of the witness on the label is marked as Ext.P-6/2.

No other witness is present.

At this stage petition u/s.294 Cr.P.C is taken up for hearing.

Heard both sides.

Considered.

Perused the case record.

It transpires from the record that the statement of witnesses namely Kanika Pahan and Khitish Pahan have already been marked as Ext.P-10 and Ext.P-11 respectively.

It further transpires that the witness Shyamal Barman could not be examined by the prosecution as he is reported to have died. Under such circumstance the statement of Shyamal Barman cannot be marked as exhibit as the witness is already dead.

Accordingly the petition submitted by Ld. P.P. in-charge u/s.294 Cr.P.C is found to be redundant and hence rejected.

Accordingly, the prosecution evidence stands closed.
