This petition came before me finally on 05-08-2026 in the presence of Thiru.D.Prabhu Srikanth, Special Public Prosecutor (Civil & Criminal) for the petitioner and the Respondent Nos.1 to 4 are remain *exparte* in the main O.A. and upon hearing and on perusing the records and having stood over for consideration till this date, this court passed the following :-

ORDER

Heard. This is an application filed by the Petitioner/Petitioner to receive the documents that could not be filed earlier. The contention of the petitioner is that at the time of filing the main O.A., the registration certificate of the vehicles bearing

Registration No. TN 13 T 3030 and TN 36 CX 3030 in the name of the respondent Nos.2 and 4 respectively, were not available with the petitioner and similarly the bank statement of the respondents were also not available at that point of time and that necessary documents are necessary to prove their claim. The respondents remain *exparte*. Considering the contention of the petitioner and further in the interest of the justice to provide an opportunity to the petitioner to substantiate their claim on merit, this court is inclined to allow this petition.

In the result, this petition is allowed. No costs.
