ORDER:

1. Vide this order I intend to dispose of this bail application filed under Section 483 BNSS by applicant/accused Lakhvinder Singh @ Lucky Bhaat in the afore mentioned case.
2. Notice of the bail application was issued to the State and on requisition, police record was produced, which has been perused.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused argued that he has been falsely implicated in this case and he was not involved in any such incident. He is in custody since long. Conclusion of trial would take considerable time, as such, he may be granted regular bail.
4. On the other hand, the learned Additional PP for the State has opposed the bail application on the ground that bail-applicant has committed heinous offence and so, this bail application deserves to be dismissed.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned Addl.PP for the State and have gone through the material on record.

6. The instant FIR been registered on the statement of Man Bahadur against unknown persons. He got recorded that he operates a fast-food stall near the liquor vend on Main Road, Pratap Nagar, Street No. 1. He further got recorded that on 26.12.2025, approximately at 09:30 PM, while he was returning home along with his stall, he was intercepted at the corner of Street No. 1D by three unidentified youths riding a high-speed motorcycle. Two of them were armed with swords (Kirpans), who alighted from the bike and way laid him. One of the assailants gave sword blow aiming his head with an intent to kill him, but, when in self defence, he raised his left hand, he received a deep cut and partial amputation of his index finger. Subsequently, the second assailant gave sword blow on his head, due to which he collapsed. The motorcycle rider then took a sword from his vehicle and gave its blow on middle finger of his left hand. The first assailant gave another blow, injuring his left ring finger, while the bike rider hit him on his back with the blunt side of the sword. Upon his raising an alarm, his friend, Dilji M, arrived at the spot. Observing a crowd gathering, the assailants fled away from the scene of occurrence on their motorcycle while issuing death threats. The complainant further got recorded that the motive for the attack was that on prior occasion, he refused to provide free food to the accused persons. The complainant was got admitted in hospital for treatment of injuries received by him.

7. On 31.12.2025, it was on the basis of supplementary statement

of complainant that Lakhwinder alias Lucky Bhath (**applicant**), Sahil, and a juvenile named Lucky were nominated in this case. Accused Lakhwinder and Sahil, were arrested. During interrogation, accused Sahil admitted handing over the weapon to Lakhwinder and in pursuance to his disclosure statement he got recovered two swords. Later on, on 17.02.2026, on the basis of medical opinion injury No. 1 of complainant was declared to be grievous in nature and offence U/s 118(2) of the BNS was added vide DDR No. 40 dated 17.02.2026.

8. The instant FIR was lodged against the unknown assailants/accused. The applicant/accused has been named by the complainant in his supplementary statement. Out of five injuries reported on the person of complainant, only injury no. 1 is declared to be grievous in nature which is on index finger i.e. non-vital part of body. Rest of the injuries have been declared to be simple in nature. None of the injury has been declared to be dangerous to life. The applicant has already faced custodial interrogation. The applicant/accused is in custody since 31.12.2025 and recovery of weapons and vehicle used in the commission of offence has already been effected. The prosecution agency has already presented challan in this case and conclusion of trial would take considerable time. The culpability of the offence is yet to be ascertained during the course of trial. No useful purpose is going to be served by keeping the applicant in custody as the same would amount to putting an additional burden on the State exchequer.

9. Accordingly, the bail application is allowed and the

applicant/accused is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing of bail bonds and surety bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- to the satisfaction of concerned Area/Duty Magistrate, subject to the following conditions:

- a) That accused/applicant will not tamper with the prosecution evidence and will not offer any threat, promise or inducement, directly or indirectly to any of the person acquainted with the facts of the case, dissuading him from disclosing the same to the court/ investigating agency; and
- b) That accused/applicant will not leave the limits of India without prior permission of the court.
- c) That accused/applicant will appear on each and every date of hearing, subject to the order of exemption, otherwise, trial court is at liberty to cancel the bail order.

10. Let copy of the order be sent to the Court concerned for necessary compliance and thereafter, attested bonds be sent to this/successor court forthwith.

11. Ahlmad is also directed to send copy of this order through e-mail to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda, forthwith, for necessary information as well as conveying the same to the bail applicant.

12. Bail application file be annexed with the main trial case file. Police record be returned forthwith.
