ORDER:

1. This order shall dispose of second regular bail application filed by the applicant-accused **Keshavjeet Singh @ Keshi** aged about 30 years son of Bikramjeet Singh, resident of Allahdita Mothawal, District Kpaurthala on 02.09.2024 in case F.I.R. aforementioned.

2. Notice of the bail application was issued to the respondent/ State/complainant/victim and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State has contested the bail application. Record has been requisitioned and received.

3. It has been averred in the bail application that the applicant is innocent, has not committed the alleged crime and has been falsely implication in this false and frivolous case. The complainant as PW1 and the victim as PW2 have categorically stated that the applicant has not committed the wrong act with the victim. He is ready to abide all terms and conditions of the bail, if any. As such, he be released on regular bail.

4. The allegations of the prosecution are that as per statement of complainant Kulwinder Kaur are that the applicant has sexually violated her daughter/victim aged about 15 years born on 04.09.2008 resulting of which the victim got pregnant. The FIR was registered and the investigation was initiated. During the course of which the victim suffered a statement under section 164 of Cr.PC before the learned Illaqa Magistrate and named the applicant and Satnam Singh as perpetrator of offence of sexual violation. Thus, vide DDR no.44 dated 21.09.2023 Satnam Singh was nominated as accused in the case. The applicant was arrested in the case on 21.09.2023 whereas co accused Satnam Singh is still at large.

5. Arguments heard and record perused with the able assistance of learned counsel for the applicant/accused and Addl. Public Prosecutor for State.

6. The allegations levelled are serious in nature. The co accused Satnam Singh is still at large. The report of DNA test report has not been received so far. The victim at the time of FIR was aged about 15 years and the alleged occurrence was 7-8 months prior to the FIR because at the time of FIR the victim was pregnant. The entire evidence of the witnesses is to be evaluated after conclusion of evidence alongwith medical evidence on record. Keeping in view above facts and circumstances and gravity of offence, at this stage, no ground is made out for grant of bail. As such the application for regular bail of the applicant is **dismissed**. Copy of this order be placed on the main trial and the bail application be consigned to the Judicial Record Room.
