BAIL APPLICATION UNDER SECTION 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER

Applicant/accused has filed the instant bail application under
Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in the above noted case.

2. It is argued by the learned counsel for the applicant/accused
that he has been falsely implicated in this case by planting non-
commercial quantity of 7 Kilogram of poppy husk upon the
applicant/accused. Applicant/accused is in judicial custody since the date
of his arrest on 19.05.2023 and is no more required for investigation or
interrogation purpose. Apart from this case, another case FIR Number
190/2020 is also registered against the applicant/accused by the police of
Police Station Sadar Patti under NDPS Act in which applicant/accused is
on bail. Presentation of challan and conclusion of trial is going to take

sufficient time. Therefore, it is prayed that the applicant/accused may kindly be granted the concession of regular bail.

3. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the bail application and prayed that bail may kindly be dismissed.

4. I have considered the contentions raised by both the sides.

5. As per allegations of prosecution, on 19.05.2023 from the conscious possession of applicant/accused non-commercial quantity of 7 Kilogram of poppy husk was made. The applicant/accused is in judicial custody since the date of his arrest and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant/accused behind the bar for an indefinite period as the presentation of challan and conclusion of trial is going to take considerable period of time. As such, without commenting anything on the merits of the main case, applicant/accused is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. However, it is made clear that observation made herein above shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of main case. The bail application file consigned to the Record Room, Tarn Taran.
