

State vs Sandeep Singh Bedi

1. Applicant-accused Sandeep Singh Bedi has filed the present bail application u/s 438 Cr.PC for releasing him on bail in this case bearing FIR No.93 of 2014 u/s 419/420 IPC P.S. Civil Lines, Amritsar.

2. Notice of bail application was given to state.

3. Record of lower court was requisitioned.

4. Perusal of the record of ld. Lower court shows that applicants/accused became absent from the proceedings of court and his non-bailable warrant of arrest were ordered to be issued. Applicant/accused is ready to join the proceedings of the court.

5. I have considered the arguments. Since, applicant/accused has filed anticipatory bail application with pray to join the proceedings. So, considering the circumstances of the case, present bail application is allowed and applicant/accused is directed to furnish bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety surety in the like amount before court of ld. Ilaka Magistrate/Duty Magistrate within 10 days from today as per the provisions under section 438(2) Cr.PC. Further, he is warned to be careful in future, if he again absent without prior intimation to the court, present order shall automatically stands vacated. Record of ld. Lower court be sent back along with copy of this order and file of this bail application be consigned to the record room.
