Today is the date fixed for appearance of both the petitioners and reconciliation.

Both the petitioners namely Partha Paul and Rumpa Mohanta Paul are present along with their Ld. Advocates.

At the very outset, an attempt has been made for reconciliation between the parties but the same has been failed since both of them are determined to dissolve their marriage.

So, the suit is taken up for hearing.

Today both the parties have filed their respective evidence-in-chief by swearing affidavit.

Both the petitioners have been examined on oath as PW No.1 and PW No.2.

At the time of evidence, the petitioner No.1 has filed his original Aadhar Card and the Certificate of Registration of Marriage showing his marriage with the petitioner No.2. The original Aadhar Card of the petitioner No.1 has been marked as Exhibit-1 and the Certificate of Registration of Marriage has been marked as Exhibit-2. The petitioner No.2 has filed her original Aadhar Card and the same has been marked as Exhibit-3.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for both the petitioners.

It is the case of the petitioners that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 06.02.2018 according to Hindu Rites and Customs from the house of the petitioner No.2 at Village-Parpatiram, P.O Atrai, P.S-Balurghat (Presently Patiram), Dakshin Dinajpur within the jurisdiction of this Ld. Court. After marriage, both the petitioners started to live as husband and wife in the house of the petitioner No.1. Thereafter, their marriage was registered before the Marriage Registrar on 09.09.2021 vide Certificate No.WB33100203020100102509-2021-137644, dated 09.09.2021. Out of the said wedlock of the petitioners, one female child has been born. From the very beginning of the marriage, both the

petitioners were not happy due to different in temperament, habits, tastes, thoughts, increasing incompatibility and the relationship between the parties has been deteriorated and they tried to dominate each other. Subsequently, on 09.06.2024 the petitioner No.2 at her own will, taking all her belongings and also taking the minor daughter with her, left the house of the petitioner No.1 and took shelter at her paternal house and since then the parties are living separately from each other. The relatives and family members and also the well-wishers of the parties tried to effect reconciliation and for resumption of the marital relationship in between the parties but it has not been possible owing to vital difference in temperament and total incompatibility giving rise to invincible repugnance, which had rendered normal married life impracticable and impossible and fraught with dangerous adverse physical and mental consequences. Both the petitioners for welfare and future life and also upon the advice of the well-wishers have mutually agreed and decided that there is no point for the continuance of the marital relationship and have further agreed upon the dissolution of the marriage tie by a decree of divorce.

Heard the Ld. Advocates for both the petitioners. Perused the evidence-in-chief of both the petitioners on affidavit and documents filed by both the petitioners.

After hearing both sides and after considering the facts and circumstances and the documents as stated above, I am of the opinion that there is no impediment in allowing the prayer for dissolution of marriage of the petitioners.

In the result, the suit succeeds.

Court Fees paid is correct.

Hence it is,

**ORDERED**

that the Matrimonial Suit No.272 of 2025 be and the same is decreed on mutual consent.

The petitioners do get a decree of dissolution of marriage under section 13(B) of Hindu Marriage Act on mutual consent. The marriage solemnized on 06.02.2018 between the petitioners namely Partha Paul and Rumpa Mohanta Paul is hereby dissolved from this date by this decree of
