Order No.03, dt.16.06.2026 :

This is an application u/s-482 of BNSS which has been preferred by the accused-petitioner namely- **2. Jyotsna Mondal @ Jyotsna Mandal**, in connection with G.R. Case No.774/2026 arising out of Hili P.S Case No.102/2026, dated 07.05.2026, u/s-85/80 of BNS.

The Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioner and the Ld. P.P, both are present in Court.

Before commencing the hearing of the instant application, this Court specifically queried from the Ld. Advocate representing the accused-petitioner and the Ld. P.P, as to whether any application for bail has been disposed of earlier by any superior Court or if any such similar application is pending in any other Court having jurisdiction to adjudicate the same.

The Ld. Advocate representing the accused-petitioner submits that in the instant case the accused person has been falsely implicated and he has no nexus with the alleged offence. He submits that on account of the situation as prevailing the accused may be enlarged on anticipatory bail subject to any condition that might be imposed by this Court.

The Ld. P.P opposed such prayer for enlarging the accused person on bail. Ld. P.P shown me the relevant pages of the CD.

Heard both sides. Perused the said application, the contents of the CD and LCR. Ld. Lawyer for the accused-petitioners submits and also stated in the petition that there is no bail application u/s-482 of BNSS is pending or rejected before the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta or before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

The accused-petitioner is the mother in-law of the deceased. Today, the inquest report and P.M report is available in the Court. From the inquest report it appears that the I.O came to know from the relatives of the deceased that the victim was a heart patient and her heart was operated. Then the marriage was solemnized. She was well. On 02-05-2026 she felt ill at her matrimonial home. Then her husband on 03-05-2026 took her to Balurghat Hospital and also treated by the doctor and came to the house. I have also considered the P.M report of the deceased Kakoli Sarkar. In the P.M report doctor opined that "Death was due to the effects of deceased condition of heart- a natural cause".

From the record it appears that on 11-06-2026 in Crl. Misc. Case No.318/2026 one accused-petitioner Bithika Das @ Bithi Das was granted anticipatory bail by this Court after considering the P.M and inquest report of the deceased.

Considering the same, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused-petitioner is **allowed**.

In the event of the arrest of the accused-petitioner namely-**2. Jyotsna Mondal @ Jyotsna Mandal**, be released on bail by executing bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of Rs.5,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of arresting officer. The accused-petitioner is further directed to comply with the provisions U/S-482(2) of BNSS on further condition that she shall not leave the jurisdiction of the Court without prior permission.

Crl. Misc. Case stands disposed of.
