HC Karam Singh no. 1105 S/o S. Mahinder Singh R/o Village Bua Nangali, P.S. Raja Sansi, Tehsil Ajnala, District Amritsar on SA.

Stated that on 09.04.2015, I was posted as HC at P.S. Gharinda, Amritsar and on that day, I was present in the police station where SHO Ravinder Singh operated double lock and took out one sample parcel of 5 grams of Heroin sealed with seal impression SPS and RS, form M29, sample seals and prepared docket and handed over to me for depositing in the office of Chemical Examiner, Kharar vide road no. 108/21/2015. I deposited the aforesaid parcel in the office of Chemical Examiner, Kharar on the same day and on returned to police station, I handed over the receipt to the SHO which he attached with the report. Till the case property remained in my possession neither I nor any body allow to tamper the same. IO recorded my statement. XXXxxxx by Sh. A.S. Randhawa, Counsel for the accused.

I have not seen the receipt today in the court. I do not know the name of official of Chemical Examiner, Kharar. I do not know his designation to whom I handed over the aforesaid parcel. The docket was not prepared by me. It is correct that when a case property taken out and deposited in the Malkhana, an entry to this effect is to be made in DDR register as well as register no. 19. I have not seen the copies of DDR and register no. 19 today in the court. I have not brought the same today in the court. My statement was not recorded by the SHO when the sample was handed over to me. It is also correct that on 09.04.2015, my statement U/s 161 Cr.PC was not recorded by the IO. It is wrong to suggest that the sample parcel was tampered with. It is further wrong to suggest that I have deposed falsely.

State Vs. Sukhraj Singh

ASI Jaspal Singh no. 151 Amritsar Rural, at present Incharge Sanj Kender, Mehta Chowk, Amritsar on SA.

Stated that on 17.07.2018, I was posted at P.S. Tarsika, Amritsar and on that day, I was present in the police party of IO ASI Rashpal Singh and we were going from P.S. Tarsika towards village Diariwal, Sarja, Barianwala etc. in connection with patrolling and search of bad elements on private car Swift and when the police party reached near chowk Village Sarja, Bariana, one person was seen coming on Hero Honda Splendor Motorcycle no. PB 18 N 0963 from the side of village Dhulka and on seeing the police party, he stopped his motorcycle and sat on the ground on pretext of urinating and tried to throw a polythene packet after taking from the left pocket of his nikkar with his left hand in the fields but he was apprehended by the IO with help of police party while throwing the same. On asking, he disclosed his name Sukhraj Singh @ Sukh accused present in the court. On checking the polythene packet from the left hand of the accused, intoxicant capsules were recovered. On counting the same, these were found to be 60 intoxicant capsules. As the recovery was chance recovery, no gazetted officer or magistrate or public witness was joined in investigation. Recovered intoxicant capsules along with polythene packet were put into a small plastic container and converted into parcel by the IO and IO sealed the same with his seal impression RS. Sample seals was separately prepared. Seal after use was handed over to me. Parcel and sample seal were taken into possession by the IO vide memo Ex. P1.

Motorcycle was taken into possession vide memo Ex. P2. IO wrote ruqa and sent through HC Sarabjit Singh in the police station Tarsika. Accused was arrested vide arrest memo Ex. P3 and intimation regarding his arrest was given to his relative. Memo of personal search is Ex. P4. On returned to police station, IO handed over parcel and sample seals to the SHO/SI Bikramjit Singh who after verifying the intactness of seals sealed the same with his seal impression BS. Sample seals was prepared by the SHO and SHO handed over the receipt to me after use. IO prepared handing over memo Ex. P5 which was signed by SHO and witnessed by me and MHC Ashok Kumar. SHO retained the case property in the double lock in his safe custody and sent the accused behind bar. IO recorded my statement. I identify the accused present in the court today.
