

SDJM Malout vide order dated 18.10.2019. It further observed that after that the accused moved an bail application before the learned Sessions but the said bail application was also dismissed by the learned Sessions Judge vide order dated 13.11.2019. It is further observed that after that the accused moved bail application before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India but the said application was also dismissed vide order dated 05.02.2021. It is further observed that after that the accused moved an bail application before the predecessor of this Court but the said application was also dismissed vide order dated 22.03.2021. It is further observed that after that the accused moved an bail application under Section 437(6) before the predecessor of this Court but the said application was also dismissed vide order dated 12.04.2021.

Keeping in view of the above discussion, this court is considered view that when the accused has already misused the concession of the bail granted to him and when there is reasonable apprehension of his absconding again if released on bail.

So, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and gravity of the offence, this Court finds no justification to grant bail to applicant/accused Sayakat. As such, the bail application filed by the applicant/accused stands dismissed. Papers of the said application be attached with the main file.
