O R D E R

1. Ld. APP filed objections to this application. Same are made part of the file. Vide order dated 26.11.2022 bail in anticipation of arrest was granted to the applicant and report was called from the police. The police report has been already received which shows that Police Station Kunzer has registered case FIR No. 15/2021 under section 420 IPC against three accused persons, namely, Sumit Hinduja,

Sandeep Rahul, residents of Nagpur Maharashtra and Rouf Ahmad Malik, applicant herein. The FIR has been registered on a complaint made by Showkat Ahmad Reshi S/o Ghulam Ahmad R/o Gonipora, Kunzer, who had complained that accused No.3/applicant herein had introduced accused No. 1 and 2 (above mentioned) to him as carrying and forwarding agents of a biscuit and confectionary company. Accused No.1 and 2 entered into an agreement with the complainant who paid an amount of Rs.5000/= as token money for samples which the company delivered to the complainant and thereafter, the complainant made a payment of Rs.500000/= to the said two persons for supply of material which they failed to make and after some time they blocked the phone number of the complainant and their whereabouts were not known and those all of three persons have cheated the complainant. Police report also reveals that the accused No.3 has only facilitated the complainant to get in contact with the accused No.1 and 2 mentioned above. The applicant herein himself was appointed/hired by the main accused persons on Facebook as Sales Officer and has received offer letter through mail from Suman Enterprises. He was hired at a monthly salary of Rs.25000/= plus other incentives but, has

not been paid a single penny by way of salary or any incentive from the main accused persons.

2. Keeping in view the police report, the involvement of the accused/applicant herein in the commission of the offence needs further probe. Therefore, the applicant is allowed and the bail in anticipation of arrest granted to the accused/applicant herein vide order dated 26.11.2022 is made absolute on same conditions already mentioned in the bail order dated 26.11.2022. Application is accordingly disposed off and after due completion be consigned to records
