

Karnail Singh etc. Vs State of Punjab.

The present bail application presented before the undersigned being Duty Judge.

It has been stated at bar by learned Addl. PP for the State that applicant Surjeet Kaur alias Reena has not joined the investigation. This fact has not been denied by the counsel for the applicants.

Heard. In the present case after hearing arguments on behalf of counsel for applicants and learned Additional PP for the State, applicants Karnail Singh, Swaran Kaur, Narinder Pal Singh and Parwinder Kaur @ Sonia and Surjit Kaur @ Reena were granted interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 26.08.2020 and were directed to appear before the investigating agency. Today, learned Addl.P.P. for the State has stated at bar that applicants Karnail Singh, Swaran Kaur, Narinder Pal Singh and Parwinder Kaur @ Sonia have joined investigation. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicants.

In view of statement of learned Addl.P.P. for the State and in view of the fact that no recovery remains to be effected from the aforesaid applicants, order dated 26.08.2020 vide which interim bail was granted to applicants Karnail Singh, Swaran Kaur, Narinder Pal

Singh and Parwinder Kaur @ Sonia, the same is made absolute subject to the conditions mentioned therein.

However, applicant Surjit Kaur alias Reena did not join the investigation on or before 29.08.2020 and on request of her counsel, time for joining investigation by the applicant was extended till 15.09.2020 and then till 28.09.2020, 13.10.2020, 19.10.2020 and then till today but till today, applicant Surjit Kaur has not joined the investigation. No plausible explanation has been furnished by the counsel for the said applicant for non-joining of investigation by the applicant. Since applicant Surjit Kaur has failed to comply with the orders passed by this court and did not join the investigation, no ground is made out to allow concession of discretionary relief of anticipatory bail to him. Accordingly, the bail application filed on behalf of applicant Surjit Kaur alias Reena is dismissed. The order dated 26.08.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to applicant Surjit Kaur alias Reena stands vacated. File be consigned to record room.
