ORDER:

1. Record received. Heard. It is mentioned in the instant bail application that the above noted case is pending before this Court for 06.06.2023. It is further averred that applicant/accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further averred that name of accused/applicant is not mentioned in the FIR and no recovery was effected from him. It is further averred that accused/applicant is in judicial custody and conclusion of trial will take long time and no useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused behind the bars. Hence, it is prayed that applicant/accused may kindly be released on bail.

2. Learned counsel for the accused/applicant while arguing in

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the lines of bail application contended that same may be allowed.

3. Conversely, learned Addl.P.P. for the State contended that there are serious allegations against the accused/applicant and therefore, bail application may be dismissed.

4. After hearing rival submissions, it has transpired that instant case FIR was registered when on 09.08.2022 accused alongwith co-accused snatched gold chain of complainant Narpal Singh Dhaliwal. Record further reveals that earlier accused Ashok Kumar and Dharminder in the present case were apprehended and against whom challan was presented on 05.01.2023 and even charges were framed in the present case against them and thereafter accused/applicant was also apprehended against whom supplementary challan was presented on 22.05.2023.

5. Record further reveals that accused/applicant is undergoing custody since 30.01.2023 and recovery has also been effected in the present case. Conclusion of trial shall take considerable long time and no useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused behind bars. As such, instant bail application is allowed and accused/applicant is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds with one **local surety** in the like amount to the satisfaction of Ilqa/Duty Magistrate. Bail application file be tagged with the main file.
