Another application is filed today on behalf of accused/applicant for bail under Section 468 of IPC with averments that due to typographical mistake, said section was not mentioned in the previous bail application. Prayer is made to consider bail application of accused under said section also.

Heard on bail application moved by applicant/accused Barinder Kaur through her counsel. It is averred that applicant/accused is victimized being daughter of Nirmal Singh Bhangu, accused in this case. No offence is made out against present accused-applicant. She has minor children of age less than 10 years. There is no one else to look after her children. Her husband is also in judicial custody in present case. There is no direct evidence against her. She is now in judicial custody. She is not beneficiary of any proceeds of sale of PACL of sister concerns. Alleged school was sold in the year 2014 and same was never purchased by PACL of its sister companies. Applicant traveled abroad many times as per directions of Honorable High Court of Delhi in WP (Crl.) 571 of 2016. Law is lenient towards women. Bail applications of other co-accused were decided by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ferozepur. Applicant is not likely to abscond or temper with prosecution evidence. Prayer is made to allow the application. Another application is also filed, as mentioned above for bail under section 468 of IPC.

Notice of both the application is given to Learned APP for

the State. No reply has been filed.

After hearing Learned APP for the State, learned defence counsel and perusal of file, it shows that FIR in this case was registered for offences under sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC. Accused has been arrested in this case for above said offences with allegations that she in conspiracy with her husband sold land measuring 7 acres out of land measuring 16 acres situated near Golden Public School, Near Dera Bassi in favour of her servant Manoj Kumar and she has also entered into an agreement for sale of remaining land. It is also alleged that many properties were purchased by PACL group in her name. Allegations leveled against accused are serious in nature. This Court is not inclined to take lenient view against accused. So, both the present bail applications are dismissed. Papers be attached with main file fixed on 02.09.2021.
