

State Vs Sandeep Singh @ Seepa

Learned APP for the state appeared in pursuance of notice given to him in the bail application separately moved on behalf of Sandeep Singh @ Seepa, but he did not file reply to bail application and contested the bail application orally.

Police record received and perused. Arguments heard on bail application. Accused has sought his bail in the present case registered under section 25-54-59 of Arms Act on the ground that the alleged recovery has already been effected and accused/applicant is no more required for the purpose of investigation, as the same is already over. Perusal of file reveals that present FIR was registered against accused person namely Sandeep Singh @ Seepa on the ground that the accused persons was apprehended with illegal weapon and the accused/applicant was found in possession 315 bore pistol along-with two live cartridge. Further, it has come on record that accused is involved in three other FIR's of similar nature. As the allegations levelled against accused/applicant are serious in nature. Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence alleged to have been committed by the accused/applicant. I do not deem it appropriate to grant concession of bail to the accused/applicant. Accordingly, the present bail application stands dismissed.
