

Harjit Singh Vs. Amrik Kaur

Present: Shri D.S.Aulakh, Advocate, counsel for the applicant.

1. None has appeared on behalf of the respondent/complainant despite service of the notice through her counsel.

2. Accused/applicant Harjit Singh has sought pre-arrest bail in a private complaint case bearing CIS No. COMI-55-2016 titled as Amrik Kaur Vs. Kulwinder Kaur.

3. Heard. Perusal of the trial Court record shows that accused/applicant alongwith other accused was ordered to be summoned by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurdaspur vide order dated 13.03.2019 to face trial under Sections 452,323,324,379,506 IPC. However, later on complaint qua applicant was dismissed in default as complainant was not able to furnish his address. However, the revision petition filed by the complainant against the said order was allowed by the Court of Sessions vide order dated 11.01.2021. Since then case is still at the stage of procuring the presence of the accused/applicant. Accused/applicant had been serving in Army and was posted at some other place. Now, he has retired from the service. Under these circumstances, the instant application is disposed off with the direction that in case accused/applicant causes his appearance before the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate within 10 days, the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate shall admit him to bail on his furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Court/Duty Magistrate shall be at liberty to impose appropriate conditions at the time of admitting the applicant to bail. In case the accused/applicant misuses the concession of bail by absenting from the proceedings, the learned trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel this bail order.
