ORDER :

This order of mine shall dispose of the bail application
filed by applicant-accused for grant of bail under Section 438 of the
Cr.P.C. in case FIR No. 137 dated 14.05.2020 under Sections 21 &
29 of the NDPS Act registered at P. S. City Sunam, District Sangrur.

2. Notice of the bail application was given to the Ld.
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State and record has also been
requisitioned.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant-accused and learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State and have gone through the record very carefully.

4. It has been contended by learned counsel for the applicant-accused that the applicant-accused is an innocent person and has been falsely implicated in the present case. The alleged recovery has already been effected. The applicant-accused is not required by the police for further investigation. The applicant-accused is in judicial custody since 18.05.2020. The presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by detaining the applicant-accused in judicial custody for an indefinite period. A prayer has been made by the learned counsel for the applicant-accused to admit the applicant-accused to regular bail.

5. Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State, on the other hand, has opposed the bail application by submitting that heavy quantity of contraband i.e. heroin weighing 650 grams from co-accused Harpal Kaur alias Palo has been recovered, whereas the other co-accused persons namely managed to escape from the spot. During interrogation, it has been found that the applicant-accused gave Rs.50,000/- to co-accused Harpal Kaur alias Palo for purchase of heroin for her and remaining amount was to be given after receipt

of the said contraband. As such, a prayer has been made to dismiss the bail application filed by the applicant/accused.

6. From the perusal of record, it is revealed that heroin weighing 650 grams has been recovered from co-accused Harpal Kaur alias Palo, whereas the other co-accused persons managed to escape from the spot. During interrogation it has been found that the applicant-accused gave Rs.50,000/- to co-accused Harpal Kaur alias Palo for purchase of heroin for her and remaining amount was to be given after receipt of the said contraband. The applicant-accused has been arrested on 18.05.2020 and no recovery was effected from her. She was not accompanying the accused persons. The applicant-accused is allegedly a prospective buyer. The presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take long time. The guilt of the applicant-accused will be determined after the conclusion of trial. The applicant-accused is in judicial custody since 18.05.2020. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused/applicant behind bars for an indefinite period. Hence, without commenting upon the merits of the case, applicant/accused is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Ld. Ilaqa/Duty Magistrate with an undertaking to appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing, not to leave the country without the prior permission of the Court and shall not tamper with the prosecution

evidence. The bail application stands allowed accordingly. The bail application be put up before the Ld. District & Sessions Judge, Sangrur on 23.06.2020 for entrustment.
