Order

1. Vide this application, applicant-accused has sought regular bail in FIR No.541 dated 19.12.2023, under Sections 18,61,85 NDPS Act & 52 Prisons Act, Police Station Goindwal Sahib.
2. Heard.
3. Brief facts, relevant for disposal of present bail application, are that on 19.12.2023, applicant-accused was deployed on his duty at Barrack No.8, in Central Jail, Goindwal Sahib. At about 08:10 AM, applicant-accused, on the pretext of having medicine, left the jail and came back at about 08:20 PM. When checking of applicant-accused was conducted, from

the socks of applicant-accused, 2 packets were recovered, which upon checking were found to be containing 250 gram opium, pursuant to which present FIR was registered.

4. The alleged recovery is non-commercial. Applicant-accused is in custody since 19.12.2023. The presentation of challan and conclusion of trial shall take time. The remand papers are pending in this Court. The bail application is, thus, allowed and applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) that applicant-accused will appear in the court on each and every date of hearing;
- ii) that applicant-accused will not tamper with the prosecution evidence;
- iii) that applicant-accused will not leave India without prior permission of the court.

5. Ahlmad is directed to send the copy of order, through Email, to Superintendent of concerned jail. File be tagged with the remand papers.
