This order of mine shall dispose of the present bail application under Section 437 Cr.P.C. filed by applicant/accused namely Pal Singh.

As per prosecution version, the FIR has been registered on the statements of complainant Paramjit Kaur, BDPO, Shri Hargobindpur on the allegations that on 24.11.2020, she received a complaint from Sh. Jagdeep Singh, Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat Mand, Ranjit Singh, Panch, Amarjit Singh, Panch, Sukhpal Singh, Panch and Pramjit Kaur, Panch that one drain for the waste water was being constructed in the village. Daljinder Kaur wife of Major Singh, who is Member Panchayat of village stopped the construction work. Kuldeep Singh son of Pal Singh, Pal Singh son of Samund Singh, Lovjit Singh son of Jaswant Singh, Gurjant Singh son of Jaswant Singh, Gurbaz Singh son of Pargat Singh, Narinder Singh son of Hira Singh, Pritam Singh son of Sardara Singh, Kuljit Kaur wife of Baldev Singh, Komaldeep Kaur wife of Captain Singh, Sukhi wife of Jagir Singh, Swarni wife of Pal Singh were also accompanying Daljinder Kaur, Member Panchayat and she was requested to take necessary action against the aforesaid persons for hurling abuses to the Panchayat and creating hindrance in the Panchayat work. She alongwith aforesaid persons went to the spot where again the aforesaid accused person created the hindrance in the performance of

Government work and also gave pushes to them forcibly. They saved themselves by running away from the spot. On the basis of these allegations, aforesaid FIR was registered against the accused.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused contends that accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further averred that the accused/applicant surrendered himself before the police on 05.01.2021 and till today he is judicial custody. It is also contended that there is no evidence with the prosecution agency to connect the accused/applicant with the alleged offences and the perusal of the application shows that the whole prosecution story is concocted just to implicate him.

On notice, the application is opposed by Ld. APP for the State on the ground that the allegations against the accused are serious in nature and he deserve no concession of bail.

File perused. Perusal of the file reveals that the present FIR was registered against the twelve accused persons. However, among them ten accused persons have already been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 11.01.2021 by the court of Ld. District & Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur. Moreover, no specific attribution is shown against the applicant, on the basis of which, the present FIR was registered. Keeping in view of the above said facts and circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused/applicant in custody. Allegations are matter of proof. Moreover, this court considers that presentation of challan and trial will take considerable time. So, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present bail application moved by

applicant/accused stands allowed. So, the accused namely Pal Singh is ordered to be released on bail, subject to furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds in sum of Rs. 75,000/- (Seventy Five Thousand Rupees Only) with one surety in the like amount. Bail bonds and surety bonds furnished which are accepted and attested. Release order of accused namely Pal Singh be issued accordingly, as per law. Papers be attached with main FIR.
