ORDER

1. This order disposes off bail application of accused described in detail herein above. Accusation leading to the registration of this FIR is that police party received a secret information that many cases are registered against accused Baljinder Singh @ Bobby for selling narcotics and also for possessing fire arms. The informer also informed that the accused is selling the narcotics at Mahilpur area, if raided can be arrested. On this a raid was conducted but on seeing the police party accused fled the scene but during that time a pistol fell from the pocket of accused. Thereafter accused Baljinder Singh @ Bobby was arrested and during

interrogation revealed that he brought the pistol and cartridges from accused Vikas Kumar from Rajasthan.

2. It is alleged on behalf of accused that accused/ applicant has not been named in the present FIR. That, the challan of above-said case has not been presented so far and as such the Trial of the case will take sufficient time for its completion and no purpose will be solved by keeping the accused/ applicant in judicial custody.

3. Application has been opposed by the State.

4. I have heard Ld. Counsel for the parties and have gone through the police file with their able assistance. The accused applicant is in custody since 21.6.23.

5. For all that has been discussed above, without meaning to express any opinion on the merits of the case, it is found to be a fit case to extend benefits of bail to accused /applicant as no useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused for indefinite period as prosecution will take its own time to conclude the trial, as such applicant/accused ordered to be admitted to bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount with Trial/Ilaqa/duty Judge. Subject to the condition that accused will not try to tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner and will not leave the country without prior permission of court. Copy of this order be sent to the Trial Court. Papers be consigned to records after due compilation.
