Record is put up today as the fixed date was declared holiday on the account of 125th Birth Anniversary of Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee.

This day is fixed for hearing of the Criminal Misc case u/s. 483 of the BNSS filed on behalf of the accused/petitioner, namely, **Suman Das** against the order of rejection of bail passed by the Ld. A.C.J.M., Gangarampur at Buniadpur on 17.05.2026, arising out of Gangarampur P.S Case No. 283 of 2026 dated 16-05-2026 u/s 85/117(2)/109(1)/80/103(1)/3(5) of the B.N.S with G.R. Case No. 675 of 2026.

TCR is received and C.D is produced. P.M Report is tagged with the C.D.

Petition u/s. 483 of the B.N.S is taken up for hearing.

Heard both the sides. Considered.

Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioner submitted that no bail application either rejected or pending before the higher Court and that the accused-petitioner is falsely implicated in this case and that this is a purely after thought case inasmuch as, there is delay of about 06 months in lodging the FIR and that he is in custody since 17-05-2026 and as such under any condition the accused-petitioner may be granted bail and in that event he shall abide by every such condition as would be imposed in this behalf.

The Ld. Addl. P.P-in-charge objected the bail prayer submitting inter-alia that the nature of the accusation is very serious and there are prima facie materials available in the C.D in support of the accusation u/s 80/85 or alternatively 103(1) of the BNS and as such bail petition should not be considered at this stage.

Admittedly, this case is a case u/s 85/117(2)/109(1)/80/103(1)/3(5) of the B.N.S and the FIR was lodged on 16-05-2026 i.e. almost 3 ½ months after the death of the victim. The victim admittedly was admitted at MR Bangur Hospital, Kolkata with burn injuries and under went treatment for about 02 months and finally succumbed to death.

The C.D does not reveal that immediately before death any dying declaration was recorded at Bangur Hospital. However, one U.D case was initiated in Kolkata and the postmortem of the dead body was accordingly done in connection with the UD case. The C.D reveals, no immediate action was taken at the instance of the paternal relatives of the deceased immediately after the

death. The FIR was registered long after a gap of about 3 ½ months from the date of death of the deceased. Such, inordinate delay in the matter of lodging FIR is not free from doubt. Besides, there is no prima facie material in the C.D showing the fact that immediately before the alleged incident of burning the victim was subjected to cruelty on demand of dowry.

Considering everything, I am of the humble view that the accused-petitioner may be released on interim bail with certain condition to be strictly followed.

Hence, it is ordered,

that the bail application of the accused-petitioner is considered and allowed.

Accordingly, the accused-petitioner, **Suman Das** may find interim bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 5000/- each out of which one must be local/ cash subject to the satisfaction of Ld. A.C.J.M., Gangarampur at Buniadpur with further condition that the accused shall not tamper the prosecution evidence and shall never intimidate any witness connected with this case and shall meet the I.O once in a week until submission of C.S and shall further comply with the provision of section 480(3) of the BNSS.

Interim bail shall remain in force till 07-08-2026.

A copy of this order be sent to the Ld. ACJM, Gangarampur at Buniadpur, for information and he is requested to issue release order after accepting the bond if it is found fit.

Thus, this Crl. Misc Case No. 86 of 2026 is disposed of.
