

State Vs. Varun Kumar @ Shaifi & Ors.

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ORDER

1. Heard on regular bail application filed on behalf of accused/applicant Varun Kumar @ Shaifi son of Vijay Kumar, resident of Chhabra Street, Jalalabad, Tehsil Jalalabad, District Fazilka, in FIR No.149 dated 24.12.2018, Under section 379/411/465/467/468/471/472 of IPC.

2. Notice of the bail application was given to the State which has not filed written reply, yet contested the same.

3. Briefly, it is submitted by the learned counsel for applicant that applicant is innocent and have been falsely implicated in the present case. Moreover, recovery has already been effected. Hence, prayed for grant of bail to the applicant.

4. Whereas, Learned Addl. P.P for the State has argued that considering the seriousness of the allegations against accused, he is not entitled for the relief of bail and thus prayed for the dismissal of the application.

5. Since the recovery has already been effected from the

accused and applicant is in custody since 23.12.2018. Moreso, the allegations against the applicant is under Section 379 and 411 IPC. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused/applicant in custody. Hence, the accused/applicant Varun Kumar @ Shaifi is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety in like amount, subject to the conditions as under:-

- Applicant shall appear before the learned trial court on each and every date of hearing.
- Applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of learned trial court.
- Applicant shall not make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with this case.

6. Bail bonds furnished which are accepted and attested. Release warrant of applicant be issued forthwith. File be attached with the remand papers.
