Accused Rajiv Rajan Singh has come present in the court and moved first regular bail application seeking concession of bail to him. It has been averred in the application that although, he has been summoned by this court vide order dated 23.11.2023 for the offence as mentioned in the said order but he is innocent and has not committed any offence as alleged in the complaint. Further, accused has undertaken to abide by all the terms and conditions imposed by this court while granting him concession of bail and also showed his readiness to furnish the requisite bail bond and surety bond

as per order of this court. It is further submitted that he has not filed any bail application before any superior court and the same fact is mentioned which is mandatory as per the order of Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in case titled as '**Vijay Kumar @ Vijay Vs. State of Punjab, CRM-M-21526-2021**'. Lastly it is prayed that the applicant/accused may be granted concession of bail in terms of provisions contained in Section 437 of Cr.P.C. Hence, this application.

On the other hand, learned counsel for complainant has opposed the contents of bail application.

I have perused the case file. Perusal of record shows, accused Rajiv Rajan Singh has been summoned vide order dated 23.11.2023 under Sections 323, 354, 447, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC. The service of all the accused are yet to be effected in the case and trial of this case is going to take some considerable time. No useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused Rajiv Rajan Singh behind bars which will be a burden to state exchequer. Thus, the instant application is hereby allowed and applicant/accused Rajiv Rajan Singh is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/-. The requisite bail bond and surety bond have been furnished. The same are accepted and attested. The papers be attached with the main file.
