ORDER

1. Bail application on behalf of accused-applicant (described in detail herein above) moved, who is in custody since 23.08.2019 on the allegation that accused found in possession of
(500 tablets, average weight 454 mg) (500x454=227gm) (Tridol)
(non-NDPS)
(50 tablets, average weight 415 mg) (50x415=20.75 gm) (Tramadol).

(300 tablets, average weight 143 mg) (300x143=42.900 gm)

Alprazolam, which is non-commercial quantity.

Ld. Addl. PP opposed the bail application by arguing that the narcotic trade is a big challenge not only to the health and prosperity of citizens, but to the security of the nation also.

Since recovered contraband from the accused falls in the category of non-commercial, no useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused for indefinite period as the prosecution will take its own time to conclude the trial, as such applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to the condition that accused will not try to tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner and will not leave the country without prior permission of this Court.

The copy of this order be placed with the remand papers and this file be consigned to the record room.
