This petition is filed on behalf of the Petitioners to modify the condition imposed in bail U/S.483(1) (a) of BNSS.

This petition is coming on this day for final hearing before this Court in the presence of Tmt.J.Sabitha, Advocate for the Petitioners/Accused and Thiru.P.Pakkiri, Public Prosecutor for the State and after perusing the petition and after hearing the arguments of both sides, this court delivers the following:

ORDER

Heard on both side.

This condition relaxation application is perused. Both sides arguments are heard in open court.

The Learned Counsel for the Petitioners/Accused has contended that the Petitioners/Accused have been released on bail for the alleged offences u/sec. 123, 275 of BNS Act r/w 20(b)(ii)(A), 8(C) of NDPS Act as per order of the Hon'ble Principal District & Sessions Court, Cuddalore in Crl.M.P.No.484/2026, dated 03.02.2026 with a condition that Petitioners/Accused are ordered to be released on bail on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Cuddalore and on further conditions that the Petitioners/Accused shall appear before the SHO, Respondent Police Station daily at 10.30 A.M. for 30 days and thereafter on every 1st day of English Calendar month till charge sheet filed. Thereafter, the Petitioners/Accused filed the petition in Crl.M.P.No.1375/2026 to modify the condition and the same was allowed by the Principal District & Sessions Court on 09.04.2026 and condition modified that **one blood surety** instead of two sureties. But the petitioner is unable to furnish the sureties as modified by the court since the petitioners/accused are languishing in Central Prison from 03.02.2026 for more than 92 days. If the condition is modified, the petitioners will furnish bail bonds or sureties. Hence, she prays to modify the condition imposed by this Court.

The Learned Public Prosecutor contended that already the earlier bail order condition was modified. But the petitioner again come forward this application to another modification. Hence, he has raised serious objection to modify the condition.

Considering the both side rival submissions and considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the nature of the offence and other aspects and already this condition was sufficiently modified, this Court is not inclined to modify the earlier condition.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed.
