This day is fixed for hearing of the Criminal Misc case u/s. 483 of the BNSS filed on behalf of the accused/petitioner, namely, **Pintu Chandra Sarkar**, arising out of Gangarampur P.S Case No. 162 of 2026 dated 25-03-2026 u/s 109(1)/118(2)/126(2)/351(2) of the B.N.S adding Section 61 (2) of the BNS and section 25 (1-A)/25(1-B)(a)/27 of the Arms Act with G.R. Case No. 380 of 2026.

TCR is received and C.D is produced.

Ld. Advocate Mr. Abu Tahir Rahaman, is present in Court today on behalf of the prosecution.

Petition u/s. 483 of the B.N.S is taken up for hearing.

Heard both the sides. Considered.

Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioner submitted that no bail application either rejected or pending before the higher Court and that the accused-petitioner is falsely implicated in this case and he is in custody since 28-03-2026. Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioner further submitted that he this Court has already granted bail to the other co-accused persons and there is no chance of early trial, though C.S has already been submitted and as such he may be granted bail on any condition whatsoever and in that event he shall abide by every such condition.

Ld. Addl. P.P-in-charge vehemently objected the bail prayer submitting inter-alia that recovery of a Fire Arm has been made from the custody of this accused-petitioner and he is one of the prime accused persons involved with the alleged offence and there is every apprehension that in the event of granting bail, the accused-petitioner may misuse the liberty and intimidate the prosecution witnesses and as such he should not be granted bail.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

As a matter of fact that this is case u/s 109(1)/118(2)/126(2)/238/351(2)/61(2) of the B.N.S R/W section 25(1-A)/25(1-B)(a)/27/35 of the Arms Act in which the accused-petitioner has been in custody since 28-03-2026 i.e. is almost 96 days more or less within which no bail petition has been filed or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court. Besides the accused also under went P.C interrogation and C.S having been submitted scope of further custodial interrogation automatically vanishes. The record reveals that a Fire Arm was recovered from the joint custody

of 03 accused persons out of whom the present accused-petitioner is one, besides, the accused is also named in the FIR. Be that as it may, there being no further scope of custodial interrogation and there being no hope of early trial, I find no justification to extend the detention of the accused-petitioner in the J.C, thus, this Court finds no solid ground to refuse the bail prayer of the accused-petitioner.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the accused-petitioner is considered and allowed.

Accordingly, the accused-petitioner, **Pintu Chandra Sarkar** may find interim bail on furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 5000/- each out of which one must be local/ case subject to the satisfaction of Ld. A.C.J.M., Gangarampur at Buniadpur with further condition that the accused-petitioner shall not intimidate the witness of the prosecution and shall not enter the jurisdiction of the Gangarampur P.S under any circumstances until further order and shall further comply with the provision of section 480(3) of the BNSS.

In the event of furnishing bond the accused shall furnish before the Court full particulars of the place where he would be residing.

A copy of this order be sent to the Ld. ACJM, Gangarampur at Buniadpur, for information and he is requested to issue release order after accepting the bond if it is found fit.

Thus, this Crl. Misc Case No. 83 of 2026 is disposed of.
