Hence, it is

ORDERED

that the accused persons (A1 to A5) on Court bail namely **1. Manik Mandal @ Sudip Kr. Mandal, 2.Subhankar Saha, 3. Dipankar Saha, 4. Bapan Paul and 5. Chanchu Mandal @ Nitai** are acquitted under Section 255 (1) of the Cr. P. C. from the charge of offence punishable under Section **341/447/323/506/34** of Indian Penal code.

The accused persons are set at liberty subject to the provisions of Sec. 437A Cr. P.C.

In compliance of the judgment of the Hon'ble Court being C.R.A. 266 of 2020 with C.R.A.N. 01 of 2020 in the case of *Sabitri Bhunya V/s. State of West Bengal*. Let a copy of this judgment be forwarded to the District Magistrate, Dakshin Dinajpur and to the Ld. Chairman, SDLSC, Gangarampur at Buniadpur for due intimation to the victim as defined under section 2(wa) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Be it mentioned that the victim has a right to prefer an appeal against this judgment under proviso to Sec. 372 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and if necessary, to avail free legal assistance through the Legal Services Authority concerned to prefer and prosecute such appeal.

They are on Court bail and bail bonds shall remain in force for the next six months as per the mandate laid down in Section 437A of the Cr. P. C.

The seized article, if any, be disposed as per law.

Let the Judgment noted in **separate** pages duly sealed and signed be kept with the record.

Thus, this case is disposed of on contest.
