This petition is coming for hearing before me on this day in the presence of Thiru.M.Thiruganamoorthy, Advocate for the Petitioner/Accused and of Public Prosecutor for the Respondent and this Court made the following

ORDER

This petition is filed U/s.483 of BNSS for seeking bail.

Prosecution case is that the FIR was registered as against the Petitioner/Accused for the alleged offences punishable U/Ss.318(3) @ 318(4) of BNS for the alleged occurrence on 25.02.2025 and the Petitioner/Accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 18.05.2026.

The Learned Counsel for the Petitioner/Accused has contended that the Respondent Police have registered an FIR as against the Petitioner/Accused and he is falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence as alleged in FIR. He further stated that the Petitioner/Accused is innocent and no way connected with the case. Hence, prays to allow the petition.

The Petitioner/Accused is in judicial custody for the past 18 days.

Earlier petition was dismissed by Magistrate Court in CrI.M.P.No.1179/2026 on 29.05.2026.

The Learned Public Prosecutor contended that the Petitioner/Accused is in judicial custody for the past 18 days only. As per FIR, there is specific overtact against him. The offence is grave in nature. The investigation is at early stage. Hence, he has serious objection to release the Petitioner/Accused on bail.

Heard both sides.

Considering the rival submissions of both sides and considering the strong objection of the learned Public Prosecutor and facts and circumstances of the case and considering that the offence is grave in nature and also considering the version of FIR and the investigation investigation is at early stage, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the Petitioner/Accused.

Hence, the petition is dismissed.
