**JUDGMENT**

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Police) alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 281 of **Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita** , U/Sec 185(a) of **MOTOR VEHICLES ACT** .

2. The Accused is present. The particulars of the above said offence are read over and explained to the Accused to which Accused pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that the plea is made voluntary. Hence the plea of the Accused is accepted. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am satisfied that the following sentence shall meet the ends of the justice.

In the result, the Accused convicted for the offence punishable under Section 185(a) of the **MOTOR VEHICLES ACT** and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.0/- and simple imprisonment till the rising of the court. The Accused is further convicted for the offence punishable under Section 281 of the **Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita** and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.500/-. In case of the default of the Accused in paying the said fine amount, Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 1 Day.

The properties produced in this case, if any, shall be disposed of as per law.
