

BEFORE LOK ADALAT HELD ON 12-11-2022

ORDER

As parties are already filed joint memo. In the case of **Devamma V/s Register Birth and Death, Mysore** report in AIR 2004 Karnataka 221- Our Hon'ble **High Court** has observed that the correctness or otherwise of the date of birth concerned is totally irrelevant in the proceedings under section 13 (3) of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act 1969 and it is only the fact of birth that is relevant.

Hence, the respondent is directed to enter the date of Birth of the petitioner by name **Sakshi D/o Ambaraya, in the concerned register as 04-08-2016**, after collecting the prescribed fee in that behalf. This entry shall not be the conclusive proof regarding the date of birth of if it is disputed in any criminal case or litigation.
