ORDER:

1. Report of the SHO PS Sadar received and perused. It is submitted in the application that car bearing registration No.PB-08-FL-0082 MG Motor India Pvt. Ltd. Hector Plus6 has been taken into custody by the police of P.S.Sadar, Phagwara. Applicant is the real owner of said vehicle being Prop. of M/s. Shree Balaji Industries and wants to release the same on Sapurdari. It is also submitted that applicant is ready to abide by the terms and conditions to be imposed by the Court. It is prayed that the said vehicle may kindly be released on sapurdari. Along with the application, the applicant has also attached copy of FIR, copy of insurance of said vehicle, copy of copies of GST registration form and copy of Aadhar card etc.

2. Notice of the application was given to ld. APP for the State. However, no reply to the present application was filed and same was orally contested on the ground that the said vehicle is case property and required during trial. Prayer for dismissal of the application has been made.

3. Heard. As per record, the said vehicle is registered in the name of Shree Balaji Industries, Zinda Road Beside Reliance Infocom, G.T.Rod Bye Pass, Jalandhar and applicant is proprietor of said firm. As per report of police, the said vehicle is in possession of police, which has been totally burnt and police has no objection if the said vehicle is released to the applicant. The Court is satisfied that no useful purpose will be served by keeping the said vehicle in custody. Accordingly, the above mentioned vehicle is ordered to be released on furnishing sapurdari bonds in sum of **Rs.18 Lakh**, subject to following conditions:

- i. The applicant shall not change the colour, shape or condition of vehicle during the pendency of the case.
- ii. The applicant shall produce the vehicle in the court as and when directed by the court.
- iii. The applicant shall not transfer the ownership of the vehicle during the pendency of case.
- iv. Investigating Officer is further directed to get the photographs of vehicle clicked from different angles at the expense of applicant and place the same on record.

Sapurdari/surety bonds not furnished. Accordingly, instant application stands disposed off. Papers be attached with pending papers, if any.
