The record is taken up for hearing ad-interim injunction u/o XXXIX
Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC.

This is a suit for perpetual injunction filed by the plaintiff against the
defendants under Copyright Act.

At the time of hearing, Learned Advocate for the plaintiff, referring
the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court in CO No.45 of 2026, argued
that there is a similar case filed before the Learned District Judge, Jalpaiguri
and the Hon'ble High Court considering the urgency of the matter has been
pleased to pass interim order of injunction against the defendant.

Gone through the facts of the present case as well as the facts of the
case filed by the Hon'ble High Court in CO No.45 of 2026 and it appears
that both the cases are similar and the Hon'ble High Court has been pleased
to pass interim order of injunction restraining the defendant/opposite party
from infringing or enabling the copyright of the petitioner in relation to the
products of 'RANJEET' artistic work in considering the application of ad-
interim injunction filed by the plaintiff.

I find there is urgency in the matter and in order to avoid further
multiplicity of the suit, I think the prayer for ad-interim injunction should be
allowed.

Hence, the defendant and his men and agents are hereby restrained
from infringing or enabling the copyright of the petitioner in relation to the
products of 'RANJEET' artistic work till the disposal of the temporary
injunction petition.

Issue notice upon the respective defendants to show cause as to why
the temporary injunction petition shall not be allowed.

Notice be issued along with the copy of the petition upon the
defendants and an affidavit of service be filed.

Plaintiff is directed to take steps.
