

Smt. Purba Karmakar Vs. Sri Gopal Ghosh

Order No. 04 dated 02/07/2026

Today is fixed for appearance of both parties before this Court.

Both petitioner no. 1 and petitioner no. 2 are present in Court.

Ld. Advocates of both sides are also present.

Before taking up the matter, this Court takes an endeavour to reconcile the dispute between the parties so that they may resume their conjugal life once again. However, the attempt of reconciliation fails.

The case is taken up for hearing.

Both sides filed their respective affidavits-in-chief. Petitioner No. 1 and Petitioner No. 2 are examined one after another as PW-1 and PW-2 respectively. The Aadhaar Card of petitioner no. 1 and the birth certificate of her daughter have been marked as Exhibit – 1 & 2 respectively. Similarly, the Aadhaar Card of petitioner no. 2 and Marriage Registration Certificate have been marked as Exhibits. - 3 & 4 respectively.

Both parties have filed child custody/ parenting plan affidavit jointly as per the guidelines of the Hon'ble Court.

Heard the Ld. Advocates for both the parties. Considered.

Now, the case is taken up for passing order.

This is a petition u/s 28 of the Special Marriage Act 1954 filed by the Petitioner No. 1 **Smt. Purba Karmakar** and Petitioner No. 2 **Sri Gopal Ghosh**, praying for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce.

Petitioner Nos. 1 & 2 have appeared today before this Court. The original petition u/s 28 of the Special Marriage Act, 1954 was filed on **25/11/2025**. The second motion is taken up on expiry of the statutory period of six months after the date of presentation of the petition referred above.

During enquiry, it appears that the parties are living separately for a period of one year or more and they have not been able to live together and accordingly, have mutually agreed to dissolve the marriage.

This court is satisfied that a marriage has been solemnized between the parties and the averments made in the petition are true for passing a decree of divorce declaring the marriage to be dissolved with effect from the date of decree.

Hence, it is

Ordered

That the Mat Suit be and the same is decreed on consent.

The marriage solemnized between the petitioners namely **Smt. Purba Karmakar** and **Sri Gopal Ghosh** on **22/09/2023** is dissolved by a decree of divorce u/s 28 of Special Marriage Act, 1954.

Decree be drawn accordingly. Both parties are strictly directed to abide-by the child custody and parenting plan affidavit filed by them.
