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ORDER BELOW EXH. 13

This application under Section 503 of B.N.S.S. for return of property seized vehicle i.e. Splendor motorcycle bearing Registration No. MH-10-DA-7473.

2. The core of application that the police has seized said motorcycle from applicant in C.R.No.90/2026. Applicant is registered owner of the seized motorcycle and was using the said motorcycle for his daily work. Matter will take time to decide on merits and if by the time the motorcycle will remain at police station, it will damage which will cause irreparable loss to the applicant. Accordingly, applicant prayed for to return of the motorcycle. The application is supported by affidavit of applicant Shaharukh Ibrahim Shaikh (Exh.14).

3. On receipt of this application notice was issued to the prosecution. In response to it prosecution appeared but inspite ample opportunity it failed to file say to this application.

4. Court considered argument. On going through the record it is to be seen that the applicant has produced certificate of registration of motorcycle bearing No. MH-10-DA-7473. It

also shows that applicant is registered owner of the said motorcycle. The offence alleged is punishable under Section 103(1), 137(2), 238, 351(2), 352, 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita and Section 142 of Maharashtra Police act and Section 3(2)(5), 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989. The investigation is completed and charge-sheet is before this court. No purpose will serve by detaining the motorcycle at police station during pendency of this matter. However, certain conditions needs to be imposed while releasing the vehicle. Hence the order :

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. Interim custody of Splendor Plus motorcycle bearing Registration No. MH-10-DA-7473, Engine No.HA10AGJ5E04686 and its Chassis No. MBLHAR075J5E03223 seized during investigation of C.R. No.90/2026 registered with Vishrambag Police Station be given to the applicant Shaharukh Ibrahim Shaikh on following conditions :
 - a) Applicant shall execute the bond of Rs.75,000/-.
 - b) Investigating Officer shall snap the photographs of the said Motorcycle and its charges shall be born by the applicant.
 - c) The applicant shall not create any third party interest on this vehicle.
 - d) Applicant shall not sell, gift, mortgage or transfer the Motorcycle by any mode except the permission of the Court.
 - e) Applicant shall produce the Motorcycle as

and when required by the Court.

- f) Applicant shall not change the nature of Motorcycle, so as to affect its identification.
