This is an application for extension of interim for 30 days filed under Sec.483 BNSS on behalf of applicant/accused Saksham.

Arguments heard.

It is contended by the Ld. Counsel that the grandfather of the applicant got expired on 06.01.2026 and the applicant has been granted interim bail for 15 days vide order dt. 05.01.2026. That the *tehrvin* of the grandfather of the applicant was done on 19.01.2026. That the *Satarvin* is to take place on 23.01.2026. That the father and uncle (chacha) of the applicant have already expired. That the applicant is the only male member in his family to perform all the rituals. That accordingly, the interim bail of the applicant may further be extended.

Per contra, Addl. PP for the State opposed the application on the grounds that the allegations are serious in nature and that he may fled away if released on bail.

Vide order dt.05.01.2026, the applicant was granted 15 days interim bail. Accordingly, without going into the merits of the case and purely on humanitarian ground, the interim bail granted to the applicant/accused vide order dt.05.01.2026, is further extended till 23.01.2026 on the same terms and conditions as contained in the order dt.05.01.2026.

: 2 :

The applicant/accused is directed to surrender on **24.01.2026 at 10.00 am** before the Jail Superintendent concerned.

The Jail Superintendent concern is directed to give the surrender report without any delay. The State is at liberty to file the cancellation of the bail of the applicant/accused if he violates the conditions of the present order.

With these observations, the application stands disposed off.

Nothing expressed herein above shall tantamount an expression on the merits of the present case. Copy of order be given Dasti. A copy of order be sent to the applicant/accused through jail authorities.
